CAMPER RULES AND REGULATIONS.

1. SWIMMING

No use shall be made of the pool without a lifeguard on duty. Swimmers shall change into swimming apparel at the bathhouse only, and are to follow instructions given by the lifeguard. There will be no swimming in the lake.

2. CARS

All cars and motorcycles shall be parked in the designated parking areas. Campers who drive vehicles to camp will be asked to relinquish keys to the director. Special permission from camp director must be obtained to leave the grounds during camping sessions.

3. CURFEW

The purpose of camp will be better achieved when all campers get adequate amounts of sleep. Lights should be out, and campers in their cabins at times established by the camp director.

4. SMOKING & DRUGS

The use of tobaccos, alcoholic beverages, and drugs shall not be permitted. The nurse will distribute any medications as needed. In addition, fireworks, electronics, and pocket knives are prohibited.

5. MUSIC

Music and stories appropriate to the church camp setting are encouraged. Bringing radios and/or CD players to camp by campers is generally discouraged.

6. FOOD

The kitchen is off limits to all campers. Campers shall not remove eating utensils and dinnerware from the dining area. Meals are scheduled: Breakfast 8:00 A.M.; Lunch 12:00 Noon; Supper 5:30 P.M.

7. SAFETY

The Camp Director and the Counselors shall give the safety of the campers a high priority. There shall be no raiding of cabins. Designated boys' and girls' cabins, restrooms, and showers are off-limits to members of the opposite sex at all times. By law, fireworks are not allowed.

8. CARE OF GROUNDS

Campfires and cooking shall be at designated sites. Property, plants, and wildlife shall be treated with care and respect. Cabins shall be cleaned by each group at the close of each camping session, and shall be checked by the Camp Manager, designated Director, or Counselor.

9. FEES

Fees are established by the Camp Board and are due at the beginning of each camp session.

10. POLICY ON USE OF ILLEGAL DRUGS, PARAPHENALIA, ALCOHOL OR TOBACCO WHILE ATTENDING CAMP

The offending camper will be removed from the camp program and that camper's parents or legal guardians will be notified and requested to come to camp. The camper may then be subject to further disciplinary or legal consequences.

11. DISCIPLINE

Discipline shall be the responsibility of the Camp Director, in consultation with the Camp Manager. Registration and participation assumes acceptance of the standards and procedures set forth. Violators may be sent home. (There will be no refunds of fees where disciplinary action results in dismissal from camp.)

In signing this application I, the camper, agree to abide by all policies governing personal conduct and use of camp property. I agree to cooperate and participate in all camp activities.
