On behalf of the Camp Emmaus Board, Staff, Volunteers, Investors and Supporters, I bring you greetings and I am honored to share with you the many ways that Camp Emmaus is impacting the lives of many people on the local level, in congregations, and in the church at large.

The theme for the 2024 summer camp programming was Linked by Love, where campers, staff, and volunteers embarked on a journey to discover how they experience God's love and the ways God's love is linked by our relationships to our families, friends, and faith communities. The ministry at Camp Emmaus is one in which we continually seek to link ourselves to God's love; embodied in Jesus and empowered by the Holy Spirit. In doing so, lives are forever changed and that is why camp is more than just a setting, it's an embodied experience that we share with others. I pray we will always have that encounter and experience of being linked by God's love especially here at camp!

Camp Emmaus 2024 Highlights:

- We celebrated 76 years of outdoor ministry.
- Memorial Day Family Camp attendance was 35 and Labor Day Family Camp also had 35 people.
- **Spring into Camp** had 53 people in attendance
- <u>Summer Camp by the numbers</u>: **112 campers** and **52 staff** and volunteers representing **13 congregations** in the northern tier of the district.
- **New Programming**: Escape to Emmaus Days (Woodcarving, Flintknapping, Birdwatching, Target Sports in the spring & Shepherd's Slings, Primitive Shelters, Music Jam, Decorative Baking this coming fall), updated background check software, and new and updated camp policies and procedures.
- New amenities and features: Loader Tractor with pallet forks, gates at entrances, walk-in cooler door, Archery, slingshot and target equipment, new council fire circle at the boy's meadow, a camp telescope for stargazing
- We had the honor of hosting the Outdoor Ministries Association Board here in April.
- The *camp board* had our *winter retreat* in which we began envisioning for the next 5 25 years of ministry at Emmaus and where God may be leading us to new ministry opportunities. We're excited to dream together and imagine what camp will grow to be in the next chapter of outdoor ministry.
- Our camp staff, board and volunteers have both done incredible work extending the ministry of Camp
 Emmaus to several guest groups, and they have sought to be wise and diligent stewards of our financial
 resources. We have 4 new rental groups this year and hosted local 4-H Club, Softball Team party,
 graduation parties, and church worship services.
- A big thank you to our staff and volunteers for all the work (seen and unseen) that goes into keeping this camp looking and functioning as well as it does. Thank you for your passion and gifts to make Emmaus the sacred space that it is and will be for future generations.
- Come see us at our display booth to pick up some Emmaus gear, brochures and share what Camp
 Emmaus has given you. We hope to have a fundraising video as part of that sharing time go out on Giving
 Tuesday.
